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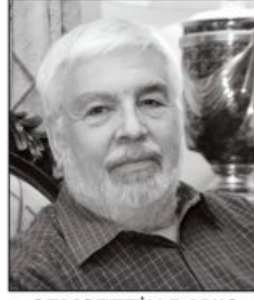

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Cyprus Evkaf Administration



Founded with the understanding of charity and solidarity and surviving for 453 years, the Evkaf Administration is known as one of the oldest and deep-rooted institutions in the world.

A waqf is the donation of a property by its owners for the permanent usage and benefit of society, humanity and all other living things. Evkaf, which was established with the conquest of Cyprus in 1571 and has remained until today, provides the administration and management of 2200 waqfs and tries to realise the endowments of the waqf owners.



Closed Marash

As a result of the lease of the island of Cyprus to the British, the waqf properties were unlawfully usurped, leading to the degradation of Evkaf and the Turkish Cypriot Community. The main example of this practice is the Closed Marash area. The proportion of waqf properties in the Closed Marash area that have been transferred illegally and allegedly is 99.99%.

Unknown Facts

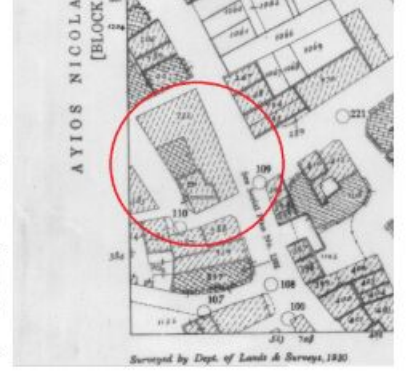
All transactions of all lands in the Closed Marash region between 1571 and 1974 have been analysed and thus the illegal transactions made over the years have been revealed with documents. In the archive studies, it is clearly seen in the maps of the British Colonial Administration that the Closed Marash region consists of Abdullah Pasha Waqf, Lala Mustafa Pasha Waqf and Bilal Ağa Waqf.

Land Registry Research

Coffee house no. 1192, shop no. 1193, shop no. 1194, shop no. 1195, coffee house no. 1196, upper floor dwelling no. 1198, shop no. 1199, and shop no. 1200 have been merged to form parcel no. 732 of title deed no. 4474.

In addition, parcel no. 731 is registered as a mosque in the relevant land registry records. The first user was the Mescit of Varosha administered by Evkaf, and the second user was the Delegates of Evkaf for the Vakif of Bilal Ağa.



Bilal Ağa Mosque and Cultural Centre

According to the archive records of Evkaf, the Bilal Ağa Waqf was established on 14 February 1821 under the name Bilal Ağa Bin Hasan Ağa Waqf.

Within the land belonging to the Bilal Ağa Waqf in Marash, there are 7 shops, 2 cafes, 1 house, 1 room, and 1 toilet.

With the reopening of Closed Marash to visitors in 2020, the Bilal Ağa Mosque also underwent extensive restoration. As of 2024, the Bilal Ağa Mosque, Evkaf Cafe, and exhibition area are open to visitors.

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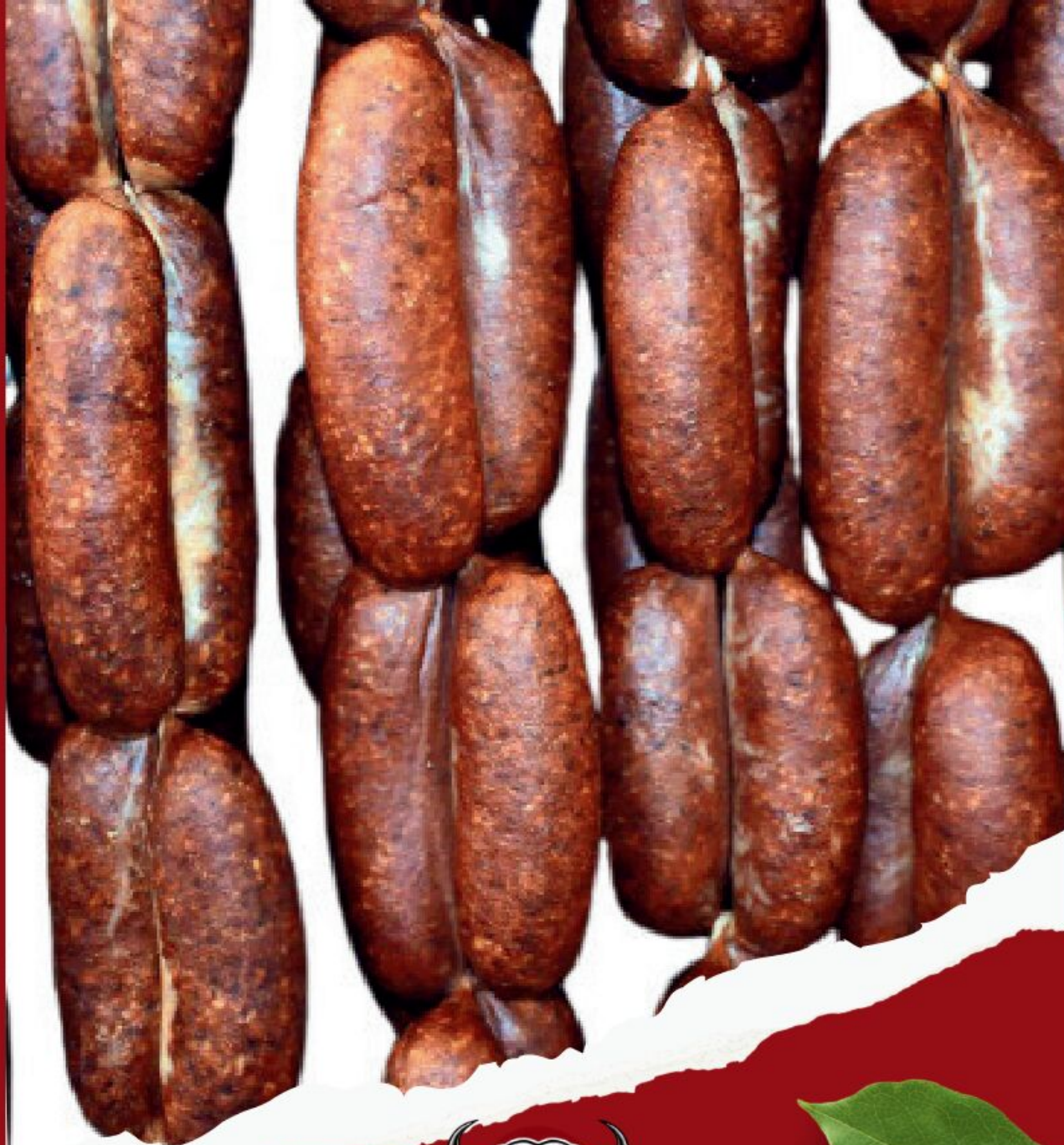
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Running for Purpose: Our Journey Through London, Windsor, and Beyond



Vitality 10k London

The 2024 Vitality London 10,000 was successfully organised and completed on Sunday, September 22, 2024. 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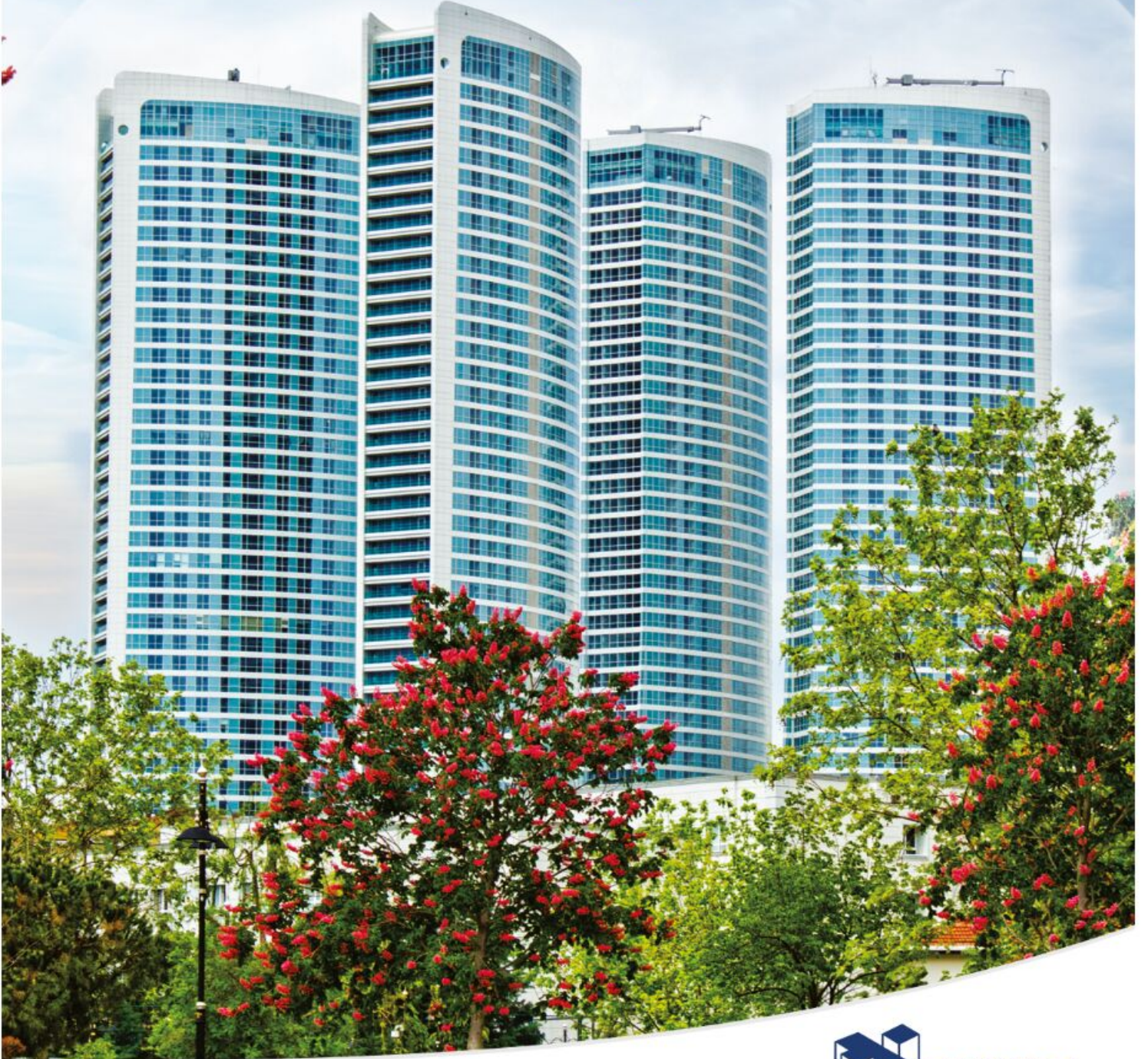


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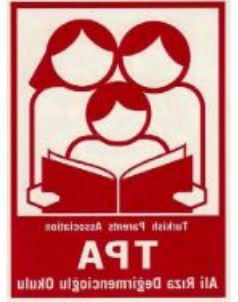


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Turkish Parents Association of UK Ali Rıza Değirmencioglu Turkish School

Dr. Fazıl Küçük Turkish School is one of the most established educational institutions in London and has been operating successfully for many years in South London. Our current premises are located within Harris Girls Academy on Lennard Road, Beckenham (BR3 1QR).

Under the leadership of our school chairs, Mr. Ulaş Tözün and Ms. Sultan Özanlar, and with the support of a dedicated volunteer board, the school has continued its operations for the past six years. Turkish Language and Culture classes take place every Saturday from 10:00 AM to 1:00 PM. Additionally, our GCSE and A-Level preparation courses support our young learners' academic success and help them pursue their desired fields at university level.

The annual registration fee is £220 per child, with a 10% discount for families with three or more children. This fee covers all language and cultural lessons, as well as after-school activities. We are committed to preparing our students for GCSE and A-Level qualifications in Turkish, recognised within the UK education system. Our efforts are reflected in the outstanding achievements of our students, with six attaining grade 9s at GCSE in the last academic year.

Our curriculum is developed in collaboration with education specialists from the Ministries of Education in Turkey and the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC), tailored specifically for children in Britain. Adhering to strict safeguarding guidelines, we ensure a safe learning environment, supported by comprehensive policies and procedures. As a member of the National Resource Centre for Supplementary Education (NRCSE), we have achieved the Silver Award, with all teaching and volunteer staff undergoing enhanced DBS checks.

We celebrate key Turkish and Turkish Cypriot national days, such as 23 Nisan (Children's Day), 19 Mayıs (Youth and Sports Day), and 29 Ekim (Republic Day), participating in events organised by the TRNC and Turkish embassies in London. These occasions showcase our students' progress in language and cultural education, fostering community unity through regular celebrations.

Cezire, meaning “island” in Ottoman Turkish, reflects our aim to research and promote the Islamic and Turkish heritage of Cyprus — a legacy spanning over 1,400 years. Since 2010, our organisation has been a proud member of the Council of Turkish Cypriot Associations. Our work is defined by a holistic, source-based approach to the history of the Turks of Cyprus, exploring the entire Muslim presence on the island. We focus on primary sources in Ottoman Turkish, Arabic, English and Greek, with research conducted across the island of Cyprus, Türkiye and the United Kingdom — including the Presidential Ottoman Archives (İstanbul), the TRNC National Archives (Kyrenia), The National Archives (London), and the British Library (London).

The association has predominantly been active in the United Kingdom and throughout the island of Cyprus, but has also carried out activities in other countries such as Türkiye and Bosnia-Herzegovina.

Cezire Derneği has organised academic seminars, conducted field research, published articles, translated

historical texts, produced original media content, taken part in television programmes, and made solidarity visits to key sites and individuals.

Among our notable efforts are the successful campaign to protect the Ottoman-era Zuhuri Tekke Mosque in Lárnaka from inappropriate redevelopment, and the inspection of early Islamic inscriptions at Limeniotissa in Pafos.

Our most memorable seminars have explored themes such as the role of the Cypriot Turks in the Turkish War of Independence, the precursors to the Turks of Cyprus, and the broader history of the island’s Muslim peoples — presented at venues including SOAS and King’s College London.

Vatan Kültürel Türk Müziği Korusu



The Vatan Cultural Music Society (Vatan Kültürel Korusu) was created by Turkan Nalbantoglu with Naci Gocen in December 2011.

It would go on to become the most successful choir ever. The groups workshops began with 19 members learning to sing the most beautiful Turkish songs in harmony. The purpose was to bring out the ladies from their surroundings and introduce them to new Turkish songs, which they would learn together. In doing so, it became a way to socialise, to bring people together and to enjoy quality time together.

In January 2012 Vatan Kültürel Korusu gave a concert in Bickley Manor Hotel to announce their new beginning in front of the Turkish press. It was an extremely successful event. Following this event, the choir began to meet weekly to practice and prepare themselves for upcoming shows.

Unfortunately, Vatan Cultural Choir has been inactive since Covid. However, prior to that time the group had been extremely successful and has made donations to

various charities. As a result of her work, Mrs Turkan Nalbantoglu has won several awards, the latest of which she received on 16th May 2024 when she was chosen as the Mother of the Year on Mother's Day. She also won from Cyprus and 6 awards from various organisations in London.



UK Turkish Islamic Trust



Masjid Ramadan was originally built as the Stoke Newington Synagogue and served the once large Jewish community in the area.

With the formation of the UK Turkish Islamic Trust established in 1977 its chair Ramadan Guney led the negotiations for acquiring the former synagogue. This resulted in the acquisition of the building and surrounding land, making it the first Turkish-owned mosque in Britain, serving the large Turkish and Turkish Cypriot community in the area.

Commonly known as Shacklewell Lane Mosque, it is one of Hackney's earliest mosques and certainly one of its largest.

Over the years, the mosque has evolved, serving an increasingly diverse Muslim community, a reflection of the changing demographics of Dalston and Stoke Newington.

The mosque holds regular events from Religious lectures annual Iftar and daily prayers during Ramadan that go live on social Media for the whole 30 days.

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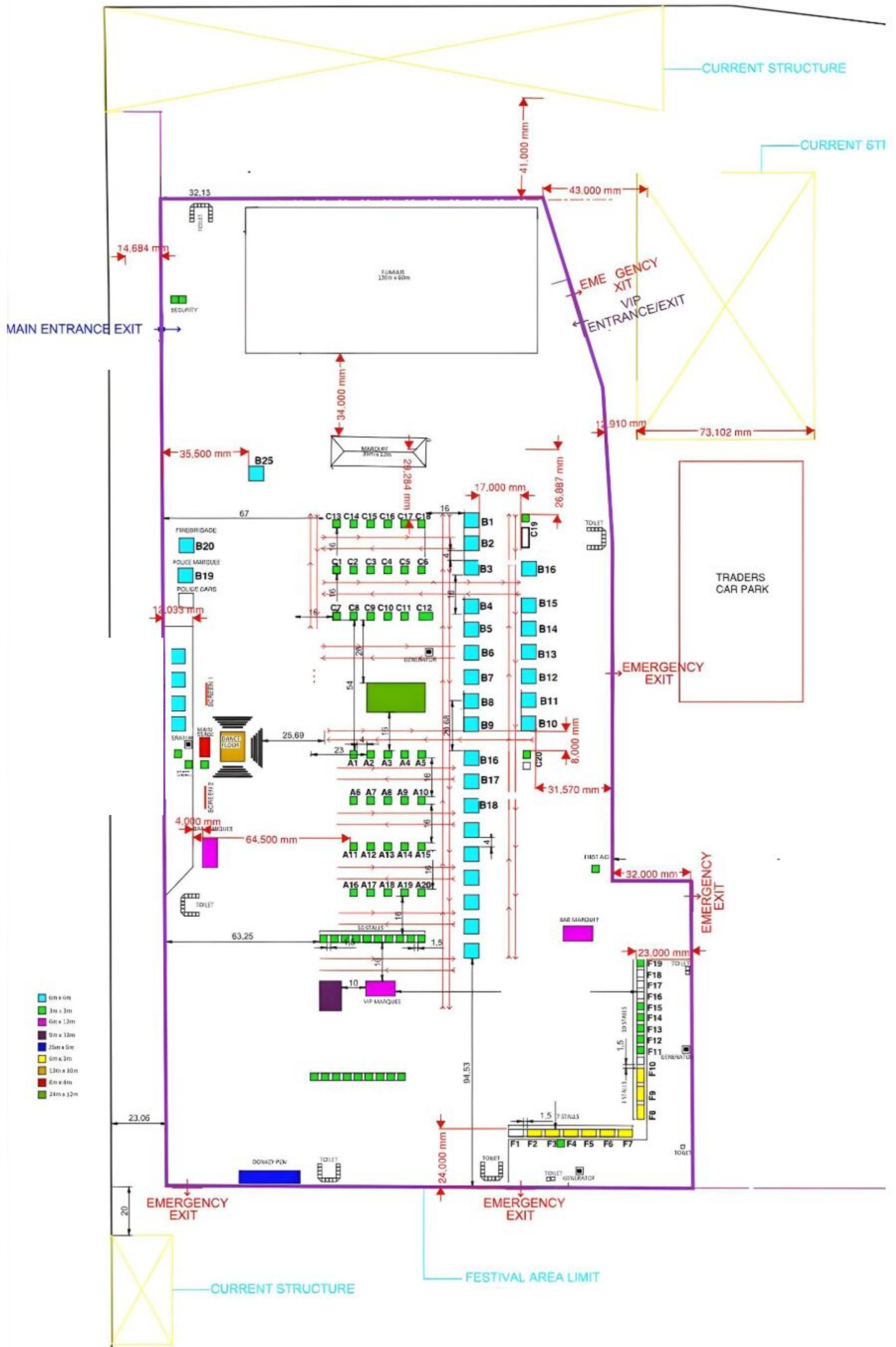




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
